- Refugees are eligible for all federally funded programs such as SNAP, TAF.
   Refugee Cash Assistance, Refugee
   Medical Assistance, Child Care, Work Program Support Services, Vocational Rehabilitation and Working Healthy
- Most medical programs are under KDHE
